Specific drop off times for your student will be finalized and shared the last week of classes. Younger students will have a shorter duration for dress rehearsal.

General Guidelines:

- **All Rehearsals are mandatory.** Students rely on each other for stage placement & choreographic timing. Thank you for your support!
- Please plan to arrive 10 minutes prior to scheduled rehearsal time to get settled and ready to go
- All students sign in at the backstage threshold (location will be indicated with signs).
 - For short rehearsals on 5/31, parents should plan to stay - these are quick!
 - For dress rehearsal and performance, no parents are allowed backstage. This is good practice for your student! Please plan to sign in and drop off your student for the duration.
- Please have your child use the restroom prior to drop off.
- During the dress rehearsal and performance, water and a non-messy snack is permitted. Please be mindful that some students have severe food allergies. Please keep food separate and no nuts, sesame, egg, dairy, fish or pineapple products.
- Children are welcome to bring small toys with them for backstage. Avoid art supplies to preserve their beautiful show day attire! Avoid highly-valued toys your child would not want to share or lose. Suggested toys: magnatiles, sticker books, books, doodle pad

Dress Code:

Please have your child arrive in class dress code to all rehearsals and performance (unless otherwise noted by teacher). No extra jewelry (post-earrings only), no extra barrettes or colored ponytail holders in the hair. Students with quick changes will wear a nude camisole leotard with plastic straps underneath their performance attire.
